SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY

All children wear uniform at Darrick Wood Infant & Nursery School. We believe uniform looks smart, is practical and encourages a sense of belonging. The school is proud of the excellent standard of appearance of the children and the uniform is kept as simple and practical as possible.

It is preferable to have jumpers and cardigans that have the school logo, but this is not compulsory. Unbranded uniform can be purchased from any store. Alternatively, Oz Schoolwear or Graduates, our uniform suppliers, have a full range of competitively priced items available to purchase directly from their shop or online.

The school also have second hand uniform available for purchase or for a monetary donation.

Please ensure all uniform and coats are named.

School Uniform

The school uniform colours are green, grey, yellow and white. All children in Reception to Year 2 are required to wear the following:

- Green jumper or green cardigan (preferable with school logo)
- White shirt, white blouse or white polo shirt
- Grey tailored trousers or grey tailored shorts
- Grey tailored skirt (knee length), or pinafore dress (knee length)
- White, grey or black socks/tights
- Black shoes (no trainers, sandals, heels or boots)

Optional

- Yellow/white or green/white gingham summer dress

Nursery Uniform

All children in nursery are expected to wear the school uniform described above. However, we have included green jogging bottoms as an option, considering their young age.

Coats

Coats should be appropriate for the season. There is no stipulation on colour.

Note:

- Long hair should be tied back
- No make-up, nail varnish, transfers or jewellery (other than small studs which should be removed or covered on P.E. days)

P.E. Kit

For reasons of hygiene and safety, children should be dressed for P.E. as follows:

- White t-shirt
- Black or Green shorts
- White socks
- Black plimsolls (infants are encouraged to do P.E. in bare feet indoors)

Optional for outdoor games

- Tracksuit (for cold weather)
- Trainers (not fashion trainers)

Children must come to school wearing their P.E. kit on their P.E. day.

All items of clothing must be clearly marked with your child's name.

Monitoring and Implementation Policy

The policy is reviewed every three years, although the Trust may vary or amend it periodically to ensure that we fulfil our obligation around the School Uniform Policy. All proposed changes to this policy would be made following the approval from the Committee.
